Dr. Suwanna Satha-Anand is Professor of Philosophy. She has served as Chair of the Philosophy Department, Associate Dean for Research of the Faculty of Arts, and President of the Philosophy and Religion Society of Thailand. Her research interests are in the fields of Buddhism and women, religion and ethics and new readings of Confucius' philosophy. Her research papers have been published in Thai, English, Korean, and are going to appear in French, Chinese, and Arabic. Since 2004, she has served as Director of the Humanities Research Forum, Thailand Research Fund.
